



Parents & Students: Directions to Register via TeamLinkt

The registration process is to be done by the parent and athlete together as both must give consent to participate. All fees will be determined by each individual school and collected directly at the school. Even though it will say that the fee is \$0.00 as you register, there will still be a fee to pay at the school. The registration process is meant to collect demographic information, medical information, and consent. As you complete this process, be sure to read carefully as there is valuable information and policies that will be shared.

We recommend that all students have a physical examination by an appropriate healthcare provider before participation in any high school sport, especially if they have any pre-existing conditions/injuries.

Directions to Register:

1. Go to sssad.net
2. Click on REGISTER NOW link.
3. Click on our school's logo.
4. Click on the sport you want to register for. You will only see the sports that your school is currently offering registration for; you must register for each sport separately if you are a multi-sport athlete. Please make sure you select the correct sport AND level. Click "Get Started".
5. Parent/guardians MUST create a TeamLinkt account or use an existing account to register their student athlete.
 - a. Please download the TeamLinkt App (iPhone or Android). TeamLinkt will be the primary communication tool for the school, athletes, and their families...
6. Go through the registration process as prompted.
7. Registration needs to be done together by both the parent and the athlete.
8. Some registrations encounter problems if they aren't completed in one session. Please allow enough time to complete the registration in one sitting.
9. Please ensure that all contact info (email, phone #) is filled in for athlete and parent/guardian to ensure smooth communication via TeamLinkt
